However, Scheider surprised the 35-year-old when he suddenly turned onto the section of the Hockenheimring that will host the FIA World Rallycross Championship this weekend. This was the first time a BMW DTM car had taken to the narrow RX track, and the duo kicked up plenty of dust.

"Rarely have I had so much fun in the passenger seat," said Glock after the action-packed trip. "It was only right that Timo should know how it feels to drive a BMW DTM car. To be allowed on the Rallycross track was just awesome. It was a great experience for both of us."
