DTM – Races 7 & 8 – Zandvoort (NL) – Qualifying 2

Félix da Costa lands the first pole position of his DTM career -Four BMW M4 DTMs in the top four.

Zandvoort (NL), 12th July 2015. One day after the first podium of his DTM career in Zandvoort (NL), António Félix da Costa (PT) is on pole for the first time. The BMW Team Schnitzer driver clocked the fastest time of 1:30.483 minutes in the second qualifying at the 4.307-kilometre "Circuit Park Zandvoort". This made his Red Bull BMW M4 DTM just 58 thousandths of a second faster than Bruno Spengler's (CA) car, who qualified second in the BMW Bank M4 DTM. Places three and four also went to BMW drivers, in the form of Augusto Farfus (BR, Shell BMW M4 DTM) and Saturday's winner Marco Wittmann (DE, Ice-Watch BMW M4 DTM).

Timo Glock (DE) also made it into the top ten, qualifying seventh in the DEUTSCHE POST BMW M4 DTM. However, he then had to pull over at the side of the track on his way back to the pit lane. Maxime Martin (BE, SAMSUNG BMW M4 DTM) and Martin Tomczyk (DE, BMW M Performance Parts BMW M4 DTM) were 11th and 13th. Tom Blomqvist (GB) was held up by another competitor on his flying lap, which prevented him from qualifying any higher than 21st.

Quote from the best-placed BMW driver.

"This weekend has been fantastic for us so far. I am very comfortable in my car and feel I have everything under control. I am obviously pleased for myself, but above all this is great for BMW. The circuit here in Zandvoort suits us, and we are getting the tyres to work well for us. In my opinion, that is what is making the difference compared to previous races. The qualifying result is fantastic. We must now wait and see how the race pans out." - António Félix da Costa (BMW Team Schnitzer, 1st)
