DTM home event for BMW at the Norisring: The BMW M4 DTM in action on the streets of Nuremberg.

- Fourth race weekend of the season, with races seven and eight on the Dutzendteich street circuit.
- Philipp Eng and local hero Marco Wittmann head to Nuremberg in second and fourth place in the driver's championship.
- Highlight of the support programme: BMW M1 Procar Revival.

Munich. The fourth race weekend of the 2019 DTM season is BMW's home event at the legendary Norisring in Nuremberg (GER), only about 160 kilometres away from BMW's home in Munich (GER). Race numbers seven and eight of the season will be held on Saturday and Sunday (6th/7th July) on the only street circuit on the calendar.

After six races Philipp Eng (AUT) in second place overall is the best-placed BMW driver in the DTM driver's championship. He has 83 points to his name and trails current leader René Rast (GER, Audi) by ten points. Norisring local hero Marco Wittmann (GER) heads to the 'Monaco of the DTM' in fourth place overall with 68 points. Wittmann had plenty of reason to celebrate last year when on the Saturday he celebrated his first home podium at the 2.3-kilometre Dutzendteich track, then on the Sunday followed that up with his first home win.

Fans can look forward to a special highlight in the support programme, the BMW M1 Procar Revival. The legendary BMW M1 Procars will be completing high-speed demo laps on all three days. The 470 hp BMW sports cars contested one-make cup races in 1979 and 1980. Legends from back then will take the wheel of the BMW M1 Procars at the Norisring this year, including former Formula One drivers Marc Surer (SUI), Christian Danner (GER) and Jan Lammers (NED).

The gaps there are always very close, so you can't afford to make any mistakes and you need to deliver a perfect race. I've won at the Norisring four times and always really look forward to being able to return to the Norisring, which is one of my favourite tracks."

Marco Wittmann (#11 Schaeffler BMW M4 DTM, BMW Team RMG, Drivers' standings: 4th, 68 points):

"Naturally I am really looking forward to it. The Norisring is always special to me, particularly after the win last year. It is always a great weekend and of course I am looking forward to having my whole family, my fan club and so many people there supporting me. Also, this year our new Premium Partner Schaeffler, who also come from the region, are also widely represented. I'm looking forward to that in particular as well, and naturally I am hoping for a successful weekend."

"The Norisring is a major highlight and I am really looking forward to it. The layout of the Norisring with its four turns looks relatively easy, but the track is far from easy in reality. In qualifying in particular you need to concentrate 100 percent so that you hit every braking point and every entry point perfectly. The gap between the first and last place in qualifying is just a few tenths of a second, so there is no room for error. And a lot can happen during the course of the race – especially in the narrow hairpin bends. It will definitely be very exciting."

Sheldon van der Linde (#31 Shell BMW M4 DTM, BMW Team RBM, Drivers' standings: 11th, 25 points):

"I drove at the Norisring in 2016 and am really looking forward to returning. We have been very close to finishing on the podium a few times this season and I am a little disappointed that it hasn't been enough yet – particularly that it was often out of my hands. But we know that we have a good pace and that fills me with confidence for the upcoming race."
