Preparing for the prestigious endurance race at the Nürburgring, MINI John Cooper Works successfully completes first test drives at BMW Group testing grounds in southern France.

Miramas / Nürburg. The new MINI John Cooper Works from Bulldog Racing has passed its baptism of fire. On the Circuit de Provence near the southern French city of Marseille, the car completed the extended test programme in recent weeks.

This is a great advantage for the racing team: Patrick develops BMW and MINI series products full-time and knows the Miramas test site from years of testing.
