The energy required to propel the car with such vigour is sourced from a latest generation lithium-ion battery, which enables a driving range of 235 to 270 kilometres.

The battery's location has the additional benefit of ensuring exactly the same amount of space is available for occupants and luggage as in a MINI three-door Hatch powered by a combustion engine.

Debut of the MINI Cooper SE Hatch at the Frankfurt show coincides with celebrations to mark the British carmaker's 60<sup>th</sup> anniversary and the stunning milestone of production reaching 10 million since 1959.
