BMW 328.

History The BMW 328 Roadster developed in 1935/36 has gone down as one of the legends of automotive history. Developed with modest means, this extremely handsome sports car quickly became the dominant force in the 2-litre class of racing. Modified racing versions topped their categories at Le Mans and in the Mille Miglia. Of the 464 examples produced, 403 came with a standard Roadster body. The remaining chassis were given race-trim and customer-spec bodies.
