History

Precisely 75 years after the first victory by a BMW in one of the toughest road races in the world, BMW once again achieved a historic triumph at the legendary Senior TT held on the Isle of Man on 20 June 2014. Following on from his previous victories in the Superbike and Superstock Class on an S 1000 RR, British rider Michael Dunlop also rode to a masterful victory in the Senior TT category on an S 1000 RR built by the English Hawk Racing Team.
