



Additional guided tours

Junior Campus Mobility Tour.

Since January 2009, the BMW Welt Junior Campus has been offering its own guided tour for children between the ages of 7 and 13. The tour begins with a research round in the Campus Laboratory. Here, teams perform tests and experiments in various areas related to the world of drive and safety. Short film sequences and an exciting quiz expand the young explorers' knowledge on the topic of "Mobility". Subsequently, they are taken on an eventful tour through BMW Welt.

The children and adolescents are accompanied by pedagogically trained staff.

The tour focuses on general mobility topics such as modes of transportation and travelling long distances, as well as the factor of safety in times of increasing mobility. Pioneering technologies also play a key role, whilst taking into account the environmental aspect and sustainability.
